Our Programs



Intentional (planned) and spontaneous (unplanned) experiences are available at every session. Experiences are developed based on the children's interests, needs and developmental stages and designed to keep children engaged and active. We love to include:

Our Educators



TheirCare educators are engaged, caring and open. We strive to provide a welcoming environment where our kids feel safe, valued and included.

All educators have a valid Working with Children Check or the state equivalent, First Aid Level 2 Certification including CPR, asthma and anaphylaxis training, Mandatory Reporting Training and Food Safety certification.



Food, food food!

Food is a wonderful way to connect and celebrate life!

At TheirCare we embrace various cultural and dietary requirements. Breakfasts include a selection of cereals, wholemeal bread, fruit, yoghurt, and milk. Sometimes we offer alternatives such as pancakes, toasties, and TC breakfast burritos! Afternoon teas can include fresh vegetables, fruit, sandwiches, wraps, dips, crackers, rice, pasta and soups.



Medical Management Plan and Medication

All children who have been diagnosed with a medical condition including allergies, food or chemical intolerances, anaphylaxis, asthma, epilepsy will need to provide:

- ✓ A completed Medical Management Plan, signed by a doctor and with a colour photo of the child.
- ✓ Medication must come in its original packaging and labelled with the child's name, required dosage, time, date and storage requirements.

Collecting your child at the end of the day

TheirCare has prepared a drop off and collection policy specific for each School and it is important to follow this at all times. A copy of the policy is on display at the service or is available from your Service Coordinator.

- ✓ TheirCare will not allow child/ren to walk home unsupervised from the service.
- ✓ All children must be signed out by an authorised person listed on the enrolment form.
- ✓ Please note there is a late pick-up fee of \$1.00 per child per minute once the service close time has passed.

Using our service

Enrolment

Enrolment can be completed online at [TheirCare.com.au](https://www.theircare.com.au) and takes 10 minutes. You will need some information and documents on hand to complete the process:

- ✓ Centrelink CRNs for yourself and the child you are enrolling
- ✓ Credit card or bank account details for direct debit purposes
- ✓ Emergency contact details
- ✓ Details of authorised nominees for drop off and collection
- ✓ Doctor, Medicare, immunisation details for your child
- ✓ Any medical or health details for your child

Easy booking options

Permanent, regular bookings can easily be set up for the same day(s) of each week. Casual one-off bookings can also be made.

While we always work hard to meet demand, we do have availability limits at our services due to room sizes (particularly for Holiday Program) - we recommend booking as far in advance as possible to secure your place.

Please note, it helps us plan and ensure we deliver an engaging, high-quality session if we know how many kids will be attending, so please book in advance when you can!



Late bookings and cancellations

Bookings made within 48 hours of the session will incur a small late fee. Cancellation of a booking within 48 hours of the session will incur a small fee. This amount varies across services, please refer to your Service Flyer for details or chat with the Educators at your school.

Fee payments

Payments are made by direct debit from a nominated bank account and charged weekly in arrears. An online statement is issued and emailed weekly.



Customer service

Your Service Coordinator is your primary contact for any assistance or to raise any concerns. There is also a board at your service that contains contact info.

Child Care Subsidy

The Australian Government provides significant fee relief to Australian families who utilise approved childcare services via the Child Care Subsidy (CCS) program. You will **ONLY pay the 'out-of-pocket' costs** for your children to attend.

Relief for **up to 90% of the fees is available for eligible families**. The amount of CCS you receive is based on your families' income and hours of recognised activities you do, as well as the age of your children and the type of childcare you use. There is also additional support for some families, including where a grandparent/s are the primary carer, families moving from an income support payment to work, and those experiencing temporary hardship.
